Code section 176A.14 provides that the treasurer of the stension council must execute a corporate surety bond to the

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1 extension district before assuming the duties of office.
2 Current law provides that the amount of the bond is 125
3 percent of the amount estimated to be in the custody of the
4 treasurer at any one time. This bill strikes that requirement
5 and provides that the amount of the bond must be not less than
6 $20,000. The bill also makes nonsubstantive changes in the
7 section in order to enhance the section's readability.
