28 2. The operator of a personal watercraft is required to29 wear an approved personal flotation device.

30 3. All persons who are 12 years of age or younger are 31 required to wear an approved personal flotation device while 32 aboard any personal watercraft.

33 4. A person must be at least 18 years of age to operate a34 personal watercraft for hire from a boat livery.

35 5. An owner or operator of a personal watercraft, other

1 than the owner of a personal watercraft livery, shall not 2 allow a person under sixteen years of age to operate a 3 personal watercraft unless accompanied by a responsible person 4 of at least 18 years of age.




