## A BILL FOR

1 An Act restricting the provision of child day care in gambling establishments, making penalties applicable, and providing an 2 effective date. 3

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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S.F. 430 H.F.

Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 237A.30 GAMBLING ESTABLISHMENTS.
 I. For the purposes of this section, unless the context
 otherwise requires, "gambling establishment" means any
 structure, building, or other facility which is owned, leased,
 rented, or otherwise operated, used, or controlled by any of
 the following:

7 a. A person licensed under chapter 99B to conduct bingo,
8 raffles, or other games of chance or skill.

9 b. A person licensed under chapter 99D to operate a pari-10 mutuel racetrack.

11 c. A person licensed under chapter 99F to operate an 12 excursion gambling boat or gambling games at a pari-mutuel 13 racetrack enclosure.

14 2. Child day care may be provided in accordance with this 15 chapter in a gambling establishment if the care is available 16 only to the children of persons employed by the gambling 17 establishment or if the child day care has been authorized to 18 be provided in a gambling establishment pursuant to an 19 agreement entered into or exception to policy issued by the 20 director of human services or the department of human services 21 which is in existence as of the effective date of this Act.

3. Except for child day care provided in accordance with subsection 2, a family or group day care home or center shall a not be established or operated in or by a gambling sestablishment. Establishing or operating a family or group day care home or center in violation of this section is subject to penalty under section 237A.19 and injunction under section 237A.20.

Sec. 2. Section 99B.14, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1997, 30 is amended to read as follows:

31 The department shall revoke a license issued pursuant to 32 this chapter if the licensee or an agent of the licensee 33 violates or permits a violation of a provision of this 34 chapter, or a departmental rule adopted pursuant to chapter 35 17A, or if a cause exists for which the director of the

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1 department would have been justified in refusing to issue a
2 license, or upon the conviction of a person of a violation of
3 this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter which
4 occurred on the licensed premises, or if the licensee or an
5 agent of the licensee establishes or operates a family or
6 group day care home or center in violation of section 237A.30.
7 However, the revocation of one type of gambling license does
8 not require the revocation of a different type of gambling
9 license held by the same licensee.

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10 Sec. 3. Section 99D.9, Code 1997, is amended by adding the 11 following new subsection:

12 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 6A. A licensee or an agent of a licensee 13 shall not establish or operate a family or group day care home 14 or center in violation of section 237A.30.

15 Sec. 4. Section 99F.7, subsection 5, paragraph b, Code 16 1997, is amended by striking the paragraph.

17 Sec. 5. Section 99F.7, Code 1997, is amended by adding the 18 following new subsection:

19 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 14A. A licensee or an agent of a licensee 20 shall not establish or operate a family or group day care home 21 or center in violation of section 237A.30.

22 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 23 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

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EXPLANATION

25 This bill restricts the provision of child day care in 26 gambling establishments.

27 Code chapter 237A, relating to child day care facilities 28 regulated by the department of human services, is amended by 29 adding a new section. Gambling establishments are defined as 30 a structure, building, or other facility which is owned, 31 leased, or otherwise under the control of any of the following 32 persons: a licensee for bingo or other games of skill or 33 chance under Code chapter 99B, a licensee for pari-mutuel 34 wagering under Code chapter 99D, or a licensee for excursion 35 gambling boats or gambling games under chapter 99F.

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A gambling establishment is authorized to provide child day 1 2 care for children of its employees or to provide child day 3 care if it has been authorized by the applicable state agency 4 as of the effective date of this bill. Otherwise, the 5 provision of child day care in a gambling establishment under 6 Code chapter 237A is prohibited. Provision of child day care 7 in violation of the prohibition is subject to a penalty as a 8 serious misdemeanor for a child day care center or a simple 9 misdemeanor for a family or group day care home. 10 The bill also amends Code section 99B.14, relating to 11 licenses for bingo, raffles, and other games of skill or 12 chance; Code section 99D.9, relating to licenses for pari-13 mutuel racetracks; and Code section 99F.7, relating to 14 licenses for excursion gambling boats and gambling games at These amendments direct the 15 pari-mutuel racetrack enclosures. 16 department of inspections and appeals and the racing and 17 gaming commission to revoke licenses for a violation of the 18 child day care prohibition. 19 The bill also amends section 99F.7, subsection 5, to 20 eliminate the requirement that a section of a gambling boat be 21 reserved for activities for persons under 21 years of age. 22 The bill provides for an immediate effective date. 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34

11 Sec. 4. Section 99F.7, Code 1997, is amended by adding the 12 following new subsection:

13 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 14A. A licensee or an agent of a licensee 14 shall not establish or operate a family or group day care home 15 or center in violation of section 237A.30.

16 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE -- TEMPORARY PROVISION. This Act, 17 being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon 18 enactment. Any agreement entered into or exception to policy 19 issued by the director of human services or the department of 20 human services authorizing child day care to be provided in a 21 gambling establishment, as defined in section 1 of this Act 22 enacting Code section 237A.30, is void and the child day care 23 in the gambling establishment shall be subject to the 24 provisions of section 237A.30 commencing sixty days after the 25 effective date of this Act.

EXPLANATION

27 This bill restricts the provision of child day care in 28 gambling establishments.

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29 Code chapter 237A, relating to child day care facilities 30 regulated by the department of human services, is amended by 31 adding a new section. Gambling establishments are defined as 32 a structure, building, or other facility which is owned, 33 leased, or otherwise under the control of any of the following 34 persons: a licensee for bingo or other games of skill or 35 chance under Code chapter 99B, a licensee for pari-mutuel

Provision of child day care in 7 violation of the prohibition is subject to a penalty as a 8 serious misdemeanor for a child day care center or a simple 9 misdemeanor for a family or group day care home.

10 The bill also amends Code section 99B.14, relating to 11 licenses for bingo, raffles, and other games of skill or 12 chance; Code section 99D.9, relating to licenses for pari-13 mutuel racetracks; and Code section 99F.7, relating to 14 licenses for excursion gambling boats and gambling games at 15 pari-mutuel racetrack enclosures. These amendments direct the 16 department of inspections and appeals and the racing and 17 gaming commission to revoke licenses for a violation of the 18 child day care prohibition.

19 The bill provides for an immediate effective date. Any 20 agreement entered into or exception to policy issued by the 21 department of human services allowing for child day care at a 22 gambling establishment, as defined in the bill, is void 60 23 days after the effective date of the bill.

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
