


EXPLANATION

9 This bill specifically identifies the Fort Dodge and Newton 10 correctional facilities as institutions under the control of 11 the department of corrections. The bill deletes references to 12 the correctional release center at Newton and provides that 13 the correctional facility at Newton will be named the 14 riverview correctional facility at Newton and shall be 15 utilized as a correctional facility for men that includes 16 minimum security facilities and a violator facility.







The opening of the new Newton Correctional facility renders the current code language pertaining to this facility obsolete. The revised language more accurately describes the current operation and conforms the language to that describing similar institutions. The Ft. Dodge Correctional Facility is a newly established institution which needs to be included in the list of facilities under the Department's jurisdiction.
