- 3 6. Once a horse has been permitted the use of lasix, it

15 treatment in a detention barn. The bill also requires the
16 commission to adopt rules to ensure the lawful administration
17 of the lasix. The veterinarian administering the lasix shall
18 provide an affidavit relating to the horse's treatment.
19 penalty for illegal administration of drugs to race horses or
20 dogs is a class "D" felony.
