A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to and making appropriations for programs for
2 elderly persons to the department of elder affairs and the
3 Iowa department of public health.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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S.F. 68

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS. There is
2 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
3 department of elder affairs for the fiscal year beginning July
4 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, the following amounts, or
5 so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
6 designated:

7 1. For programs and services for elderly persons:
8 \$ 4,000,000

9 a. Of the funds appropriated in this subsection, \$129,592
10 shall be used for the retired senior volunteer program.

11 b. Of the funds appropriated in this subsection, \$150,000
12 shall be used for Alzheimer's support.

13 c. Of the funds appropriated in this subsection, \$25,000
14 shall be used for mental health outreach.

15 d. Of the funds appropriated in this subsection,
16 \$1,195,408 shall be used for general services for elderly
17 persons.

18 e. Of the funds appropriated in this subsection,
19 \$2,500,000 shall be used for citizens of Iowa over 60 years of
20 age for case management for the frail elderly.

21 Funds appropriated in this subsection over the funding
22 level appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1989,
23 and ending June 30, 1990, shall not be used for area agencies
24 on aging administrative purposes or for the development of new
25 program initiatives unless developed through the area agencies
26 on aging planning process.

27 Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH. There is
28 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa
29 department of public health for the fiscal year beginning July
30 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, the following amounts, or
31 so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes
32 designated:

33 1. For the county health nurse program, to be used for
34 home nursing visits for elderly persons:

35 \$ 2,637,465

1 2. For the county home care aide program to be used for
2 homemaker-home health and chore program services for elderly
3 persons:

4 \$ 9,016,053

5 3. For the county Iowa senior health program:

6 \$ 801,337

7 Funds appropriated in this subsection over the funding
8 level appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1989,
9 and ending June 30, 1990, shall not be used for additional
10 administrative costs or the development of new program
11 initiatives unless developed through the county organizations
12 planning process.

13	EXPLANATION
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14 This bill makes appropriations for the fiscal year
15 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, to the Iowa
16 department of elder affairs for the elderly services program
17 and the Iowa department of public health for the home nursing
18 program and home care aide program.

19 The bill appropriates \$4 million to the department of elder
20 affairs for programs and services for elderly persons and
21 contains specific dollar amounts allocated for the retired
22 senior volunteer program, Alzheimer's support, mental health
23 outreach, general services for elderly persons, and case
24 management for the frail elderly. No amount of the \$4 million
25 appropriation exceeding the funding level for the fiscal year
26 beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990, shall be
27 used for area agencies on aging administrative purposes or for
28 the development of new program initiatives unless developed
29 through the area agencies on aging planning process.

30 The bill also appropriates funds to the Iowa department of
31 public health. Funds are appropriated to the county health
32 nurse program to be used for home nursing visits for the
33 elderly, for the county home care aide program to be used for
34 homemaker-home health and chore program services, and for the
35 county Iowa senior health program. No amount of the

1 appropriation to the Iowa department of public health
2 exceeding the funding level for the fiscal year beginning July
3 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990, shall be used for
4 additional administrative costs or the development of new
5 program initiatives unless developed through the county
6 organizations planning process.

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
