- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 473.18 OPTIONS PROGRAM FOR 2 RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS OF LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS.
- 3 l. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise 4 requires:
- 5 a. "Dealer" means a person engaged in the ordinary course
- 6 of business of selling liquefied petroleum gas to a consumer
- 7 who uses the gas to provide an energy source to a residence.
- 8 b. "Liquefied petroleum gas" or "gas" means material used
- 9 for fuel composed of the following hydrocarbons or the
- 10 following mixture of hydrocarbons: propane, propylene, normal
- ll butanes, isobutanes, or butylenes.
- 12 2. A dealer shall display and make available to
- 13 residential customers purchasing liquefied petroleum gas the
- 14 most current publication of an awareness guide provided by the
- 15 department that contains information relating to the purchase
- 16 of liquefied petroleum gas by residential customers, including
- 17 but not limited to options commonly offered by dealers to such
- 18 customers. The description of commonly offered options shall
- 19 include benefits of selecting extended payments plans,
- 20 purchasing gas during periods of low demand, and executing
- 21 contracts for the supply of gas at predetermined prices.
- 22 3. The department shall adopt rules under chapter 17A
- 23 requiring a dealer to provide to residential customers
- 24 purchasing liquefied petroleum gas an offer to purchase gas by
- 25 contract. The contract shall provide for the purchase of a
- 26 supply of gas during periods of high demand at a predetermined
- 27 price.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- 29 This bill creates new Code section 473.18 and provides that
- 30 a liquefied petroleum gas dealer must display and make
- 31 available to residential customers the most recent publication
- 32 of an awareness guide provided by the department of natural
- 33 resources which includes information regarding purchasing
- 34 options. The department is to adopt rules requiring a dealer
- 35 to provide a contract purchase option to residential

1 customers. The contract option must provide for the purchase 2 of liquefied petroleum gas during periods of high demand at a 3 predetermined price.
