A BILL FOR

1 An Act making appropriations to the college student aid
2 commission for payments to persons eligible for Iowa tuition
3 grants, vocational-technical grants, and national guard
4 tuition aid grants, and permitting the commission to carry
5 over national guard tuition aid funds.

1 COLLEGE STUDENT AID COMMISSION

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
3 the state to the college student aid commission for the fiscal
4 year beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1998, the
5 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
6 used for the purposes designated:

7 1. NATIONAL GUARD TUITION AID PROGRAM. For payments to
8 persons under the national guard tuition aid program
9 established in section 261.21:

10 \$ 2,000,000

11 2. STUDENT AID PROGRAMS. For payments to students for the
12 Iowa grant program under section 261.95:

13 \$ 1,600,000

14 Sec. 2. Section 261.21, Code 1997, is amended by adding
15 the following new subsection:

16 NEW SUBSECTION. 6. Notwithstanding section 8.33, funds
17 appropriated for the program remaining unexpended and
18 unobligated on June 30 of any fiscal year shall not revert to
19 the general fund of the state but shall remain available for
20 expenditure for the following fiscal year for the purposes of
21 this section.

22 Sec. 3. Section 261.25, subsection 3, Code 1997, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
25 state to the commission for each fiscal year the sum of one
26 million six eight hundred eight seventy-five thousand two
27 hundred-fifty-seven dollars for vocational-technical tuition
28 grants.

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill funds the Iowa grant program and appropriates
31 funds for vocational-technical grants at the levels requested
32 by the college student aid commission. The bill also
33 appropriates \$2 million to the national guard tuition aid
34 program, which was established in Code section 261.21 with the
35 enactment of House File 2477 in 1996. The bill permits any

1 unencumbered and unobligated national guard tuition aid
2 program funds to be carried over into the following fiscal
3 years for purposes of the program.
