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1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 514C.14 COMPARABLE COVERAGE FOR 2 MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT.

1. Notwithstanding section 514C.6, a policy or contract 4 providing for third-party payment or prepayment of health or 5 medical expenses shall provide coverage benefits for services 6 for clinical disorders related to mental health which shall be 7 on terms and conditions which are comparable to the terms and 8 conditions for coverage benefits provided for other health or 9 medical disorders under the policy or contract.

For purposes of this section, clinical disorders
 related to mental health for which coverage benefits are to be
 provided under this section are biological brain diseases
 including schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, major
 depressive disorder, bipolar disorder, paranoia and other
 psychotic disorders, obsessive-compulsive disorder, panic
 disorder, and pervasive developmental disorder or autism.
 This section applies to the following classes of third-

a. Individual or group accident and sickness insurance

b. An individual or group hospital or medical service

d. An individual or group Medicare supplemental policy,

e. Any other entity engaged in the business of insurance,

33 f. An organized delivery system licensed by the director 34 of public health.

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EXPLANATION

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This bill creates new Code section 514C.14 and provides that a policy or contract providing for third-party payment or prepayment of health or medical expenses must provide coverage benefits for services for clinical disorders related to mental health which are to be on terms and conditions which are comparable to the terms and conditions associated with coverage benefits provided for other health or medical disorders under the policy or contract.

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
