9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill amends Code section 321.34 to provide for the
11 issuance of motorcycle rider education plates to owners of
12 motorcycles and trailers. Currently, such plates may be
13 issued to owners of motor vehicles subject to registration
14 under Code section 321.109, subsection 1, light delivery
15 trucks, panel delivery trucks, pickups, motor homes,
16 multipurpose vehicles, and travel trailers.

The fee for the issuance of special registration plates is twenty-five dollars for each vehicle, unless otherwise provided by this section, which fee is in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The county treasurer shall validate special registration plates with a distinguishing processed emblem in the same manner as regular registration plates, upon payment of five dollars in addition to the regular annual registration fee.

Sec. 9. Section 321.34, subsection 12, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. d. A special registration plate issued for a motorcycle or motorized bicycle under this section shall be designated in the manner provided for personalized registration plates under subsection 5, paragraph "a".
