- 13 This bill amends Code section 163.43, which provides that a
- 14 breeding bull leased by a person required to be licensed by
- 15 the department of agriculture and land stewardship must be
- 16 accompanied by a health certificate issued by a veterinarian.
- 17 The bill removes a requirement that a copy of the health
- 18 certificate be filed with the department. The bill provides
- 19 that the health certificate must be issued to the licensee for
- 20 inclusion in part of the licensee's business records.
- 21 The bill removes a requirement that the breeding bull must
- 22 be tested for tuberculosis. It retains a requirement that the
- 23 breeding bull must react negatively to a test for brucellosis
- 24 (sometimes referred to as "Bang's disease"). The bill
- 25 rewrites a provision requiring that the test be conducted
- 26 within 60 days prior to the lease. It provides that the test
- 27 must be administered within 12 months prior to the date that
- 28 the certificate is issued. The bill provides that the health
- 29 certificate must state that an imported breeding bull
- 30 satisfies state importation requirements. A person who
- 31 violates chapter 163 is quilty of a simple misdemeanor.
- 32 The bill makes a number of stylistic changes in order to
- 33 enhance readability without changing current law or practice.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 163.40, Code 1999, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3. "Licensee" means a person required to obtain a license pursuant to section 163.41.

- Sec. 2. Section 163.43, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:
 - 163.43 HEALTH CERTIFICATE REQUIRED.
- 1. No-licensee-shall-lease-as-lessor, and no A person shall lease as not be lesseer a party to a lease of a breeding bull within this state in which the lessor is a licensee, unless such the breeding bull is accompanied by a health certificate signed. For the purposes of this section, a breeding bull is leased within this state if it is leased to an lowa resident.
