1 Section 1. Section 321.194, subsection 1, paragraph a,  
2 subparagraph (1), Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 (1) During the hours of 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. over the most  
4 direct and accessible route between the licensee's residence  
5 and schools of enrollment and between schools of enrollment  
6 for the purpose of attending duly scheduled courses of  
7 instruction and extracurricular activities within the school  
8 district, regardless of whether the courses of instruction or  
9 extracurricular activities take place on school property. If  
10 the licensee's school of enrollment has entered into an  
11 agreement with another school district to jointly provide  
12 extracurricular athletic activities, the licensee may operate  
13 a motor vehicle pursuant to this subparagraph to attend those  
14 extracurricular athletic activities in the school district  
15 with which the licensee's school of enrollment has the  
16 agreement.

17 Sec. 2. Section 321.194, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code  
18 1999, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered  
19 paragraph:

20 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. This paragraph "b" shall not  
21 prohibit a licensee from operating a motor vehicle pursuant to  
22 paragraph "a", subparagraph (1), to attend extracurricular  
23 athletic activities in a school district with which the  
24 licensee's school of enrollment has entered into an agreement  
25 for the joint provision of the extracurricular athletic  
26 activities.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill amends Code section 321.194, relating to minors'  
29 school driver's licenses, to provide that a person holding a  
30 school license may operate a motor vehicle to attend duly  
31 scheduled courses of instruction and extracurricular  
32 activities within the school district, regardless of whether  
33 the courses of instruction or extracurricular activities take  
34 place on school property, and to attend extracurricular  
35 athletic activities in a school district with which the

1 licensee's school of enrollment has combined for athletic  
2 purposes.
