1 Section 1. Section 388.3, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 If a proposal to establish a utility board receives a
4 favorable majority vote, the mayor shall appoint the board
5 members, as provided in the proposal, subject to the approval
6 of the council. The council shall by resolution provide for
7 staggered six-year terms of not less than three years nor more
8 than six years for, and shall set the compensation of, board
9 members, and shall set the compensation of board members.

10 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY DATE. This bill applies to terms of
11 office beginning on or after January 1, 2001.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill changes the length of term of office for board
14 members of a city utility or combined utility system from six
15 years to a term of not less than three years and not more than
16 six years. The length of term of office for a city utility
17 board or combined utility board is provided in a resolution
18 adopted by the city council.

19 The bill applies to terms of office beginning on or after
20 January 1, 2001.
