A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for an increase in the regular program  
2 foundation base per pupil, the regular program foundation base  
3 per pupil for the portion of weighted enrollment that is  
4 additional enrollment because of special education, and the  
5 special education support services foundation base, and  
6 including an effective date and applicability provision.  
7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.1, subsection 2, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 2, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 For the budget year commencing July 1, ~~1996~~ 1999, and for  
4 each succeeding budget year, the regular program foundation  
5 base per pupil is ~~eighty-seven~~ eighty-nine and ~~five-tenths~~  
6 three-tenths percent of the regular program state cost per  
7 pupil, ~~except-that~~ the regular program foundation base per  
8 pupil for the portion of weighted enrollment that is  
9 additional enrollment because of special education is ~~seventy-~~  
10 ~~nine~~ eighty-nine and three-tenths percent of the regular  
11 program state cost per pupil. ~~For the budget year commencing~~  
12 ~~July 1, 1991~~, and ~~for each succeeding budget year~~ the special  
13 education support services foundation base is ~~seventy-nine~~  
14 eighty-nine and three-tenths percent of the special education  
15 support services state cost per pupil. The combined  
16 foundation base is the sum of the regular program foundation  
17 base and the special education support services foundation  
18 base.

19 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
20 takes effect upon enactment and applies to the computation of  
21 school foundation aid payable during school budget years  
22 beginning on or after July 1, 1999.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill provides for an increase in the regular program  
25 foundation base per pupil, the regular program foundation base  
26 per pupil for the portion of weighted enrollment that is  
27 additional enrollment because of special education, and the  
28 special education support services foundation base levels to  
29 89.3 percent. The bill would take effect upon enactment for  
30 purposes of computation of school foundation aid payable  
31 during school budget years beginning on or after July 1, 1999.
