- 1 Section 1. Section 321F.8, Code 1999, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 321F.8 REGISTRATION OF VEHICLE REQUIRED.
- 4 1. All motor vehicles which are primarily garaged or
- 5 located in this state and which are the subject of a lease
- 6 shall be registered in this state. This section shall not be
- 7 construed to exempt any motor vehicle from registration which
- 8 is otherwise subject to registration under the-provisions-of
- 9 chapter 321, provided, however, that the-provisions-of this
- 10 section shall not apply to motor vehicles in fleets whose
- ll registrations are apportioned under the-provisions-of section
- 12 326.2.
- 2. If a person engaged in the business of leasing vehicles
- 14 in this state enters into a lease agreement with another
- 15 person and the lease agreement requires the lessee to be
- 16 responsible for registration in this state of the vehicle
- 17 leased, the lessor shall forward any registration materials
- 18 received by the lessor to the lessee within seven days of
- 19 receipt of the materials.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 This bill requires the lessor of a vehicle to forward any
- 22 registration materials for a vehicle leased by the lessor,
- 23 which are received by the lessor, to the lessee of the vehicle
- 24 if the lease agreement requires the lessee of the vehicle to
- 25 be responsible for registration of the vehicle in this state.
- 26 The materials are to be forwarded to the lessee within seven
- 27 days of receipt by the lessor. A violation of this provision
- 28 is a simple misdemeanor.
