- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 483A.28 HUNTING GUIDE LICENSES 2 -- PENALTY.
- 3 1. A person shall not engage in or be employed for any
- 4 compensation or reward for hunting guide activities in this
- 5 state unless the person has obtained a hunting guide license
- 6 from the department. The department shall define, by rule,
- 7 the activities that constitute hunting guide activities for
- 8 purposes of this section. The rules shall require an
- 9 applicant to identify the location and number of acres to be
- 10 hunted and to submit a management plan which is subject to
- 11 approval by the department.
- 12 2. Upon application and payment of the hunting quide
- 13 license fee as provided in subsection 3 and an approved
- 14 management plan, the department shall issue a guide license to
- 15 an applicant who agrees to faithfully perform the duties and
- 16 responsibilities of a licensed hunting guide and who agrees to
- 17 observe and comply with the requirements of chapters 481A and
- 18 484A, this chapter, and the rules of the department relating
- 19 to hunting guides and the hunting of game in this state. A
- 20 hunting quide is responsible for informing hunting clients of
- 21 all applicable hunting laws and rules. A hunting guide
- 22 license shall not be issued to a person who is under eighteen
- 23 years of age.
- 24 3. The department shall establish, by rule, the annual fee
- 25 for a hunting guide license issued pursuant to this chapter.
- 26 In determining an annual fee, the department shall consider
- 27 the costs of issuing the license and administering and
- 28 enforcing the provisions of this section.
- 29 4. A violation of this section is a simple misdemeanor and
- 30 is punishable as provided in section 483A.42.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 This bill requires the licensing of persons who provide
- 33 hunting guide services. The department of natural resources
- 34 is directed to issue hunting guide licenses upon application
- 35 and payment of an annual fee determined by rule of the

1 commission to persons who agree to faithfully perform the 2 duties and responsibilities of a licensed hunting guide and 3 agree to observe and comply with the requirements of the 4 hunting laws and rules of the department. An applicant shall 5 identify the location and number of acres of the land to be 6 hunted and submit a game management plan which is subject to 7 approval by the department. A hunting guide must be at least 8 18 years of age to be licensed. Violators are quilty of a simple misdemeanor and subject to 9 10 a minimum fine of \$10 for each offense. The maximum fine for 11 a simple misdemeanor is \$500 and the court may order not more 12 than 30 days' imprisonment in lieu of or in addition to a 13 fine. 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21
