1 Section 1. Section 279.51, subsection 1, unnumbered
2 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1999, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to
5 the department of education for the fiscal year beginning July
6 1, ~~1998~~ 2000, and each succeeding fiscal year, the sum of
7 fifteen million ~~three~~ nine hundred sixty thousand dollars.

8 Sec. 2. Section 279.51, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code
9 Supplement 1999, is amended to read as follows:

10 c. For each of the fiscal years during the fiscal period
11 beginning July 1, ~~1996~~ 2000, and ending June 30, ~~2000~~ 2004,
12 ~~two~~ three million ~~eight~~ four hundred thousand dollars of the
13 funds appropriated shall be allocated for the school-based
14 youth services education program established in subsection 3.

15 ~~For each of the fiscal years during the fiscal period~~
16 ~~beginning July 1, 1994, and ending June 30, 2000, twenty~~
17 ~~thousand dollars of the funds allocated in this paragraph~~
18 ~~shall be expended for staff development, research, and the~~
19 ~~development of strategies for coordination with community-~~
20 ~~based youth organizations and agencies.~~ A school that
21 received a grant during the fiscal year period beginning July
22 1, 1993, ~~or July 1, 1997,~~ and ending June 30, 2000, is
23 ineligible to receive a grant under this paragraph. However,
24 if a school that received a grant prior to July 1, 2000,
25 submits a program plan pursuant to subsection 3, the school
26 may qualify to receive fifty thousand dollars annually from
27 the moneys allocated in this paragraph, which shall be used
28 for expansion and identified minimum services. Subject to the
29 approval of the state board of education, the allocation made
30 in this paragraph may be renewed for additional four-year
31 periods of time.

32 Sec. 3. Section 279.51, subsection 1, paragraph e, Code
33 Supplement 1999, is amended by striking the paragraph.

34 EXPLANATION

35 This bill increases the statutory appropriation from the

1 general fund of the state for programs for at-risk children,
2 specifically increasing the allocation for school-based youth
3 services to permit new four-year grants to be awarded by the
4 department of education and to allow prior grant recipients to
5 receive funds for expansion and identified minimum services if
6 the prior recipients submit program plans to the department of
7 education.
