25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill amends Code chapter 484B which provides for the
27 regulation of hunting preserves by the department of natural
28 resources, including providing for licensing requirements,
29 fencing, departmental inspections, and the tagging of animals
30 in the preserves. The animals regulated under the chapter are
31 limited to "ungulates" which is defined to mean hoofed
32 nondomesticated mammals. The bill excludes livestock from the
33 definition of ungulates regulated under the chapter. For
34 purposes of the exclusion, "livestock" means an animal
35 belonging to the bovine, caprine, equine, ovine, or porcine

1 species; ostriches, rheas, emus; or farm deer such as elk.

2 The bill generally authorizes the department of agriculture
3 and land stewardship to establish and administer programs for
4 the inspection and control of disease among livestock.
