A BILL FOR

1 An Act creating an Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial commission,
2 an Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial fund, and providing an
3 effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 15.221 IOWA LEWIS AND CLARK
2 BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION.

3 1. The Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial commission is
4 established in the department of economic development for
5 purposes of coordinating and promoting the observance of this
6 state's bicentennial commemoration of the Lewis and Clark
7 expedition. The commission shall be organized and shall
8 operate as a nonprofit corporation within this state in
9 accordance with chapter 504A.

10 2. The commission shall be composed of seven members
11 consisting of all of the following:

12 a. The director of the department of cultural affairs or
13 the director's designee.

14 b. The administrator of the division of tourism within the
15 department of economic development, or the administrator's
16 designee.

17 c. The administrator of the parks and preserves division
18 within the department of natural resources, or the
19 administrator's designee.

20 d. The administrator of the historical division within the
21 department of cultural affairs, or the administrator's
22 designee.

23 e. The remaining three members shall be appointed by the
24 governor, subject to confirmation by the senate. The members
25 appointed by the governor shall have an interest or expertise
26 in the history of the Lewis and Clark expedition. At least
27 two of the members appointed by the governor shall be members
28 of an Indian tribe encountered by the Lewis and Clark
29 expedition.

30 3. The members appointed by the governor shall be
31 appointed in compliance with sections 69.16 and 69.16A and
32 shall serve three-year terms beginning and ending as provided
33 by section 69.19. Members appointed by the governor may be
34 reappointed.

35 4. The commission shall annually elect a chairperson and

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1 vice chairperson from the members of the commission.

2 5. Commission members shall serve without compensation,
3 but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses.

4 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 15.222 POWERS.

5 The commission may do all of the following:

6 1. Cooperate with other entities conducting national,
7 regional, state, or local events promoting the bicentennial.

8 2. Plan, assist, coordinate, or conduct bicentennial
9 events.

10 3. Engage in fund-raising activities, including revenue-
11 earning enterprises and the solicitation of grants, gifts, and
12 donations.

13 4. Promote public education concerning the Lewis and Clark
14 expedition.

15 5. Coordinate interagency participation in the observance
16 and work with appropriate federal entities such as the
17 national park service, the United States forest service, and
18 the United States army.

19 6. Appoint various local and regional advisory committees.

20 7. Perform any other related duties.

21 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 15.223 IOWA LEWIS AND CLARK
22 BICENTENNIAL FUND.

23 An Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial fund is created as a
24 separate fund in the state treasury under the control of the
25 commission. The assets of the fund shall be used by the
26 commission only for carrying out the purposes of this part.
27 The fund shall consist of any moneys appropriated by the
28 general assembly for that purpose and any other moneys
29 available to and obtained or accepted by the commission for
30 placement in the fund. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
31 in the Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial fund at the end of
32 each fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund but shall
33 remain in the Lewis and Clark bicentennial fund for
34 expenditure for subsequent fiscal years.

35 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 15.224 RULES.

1 The department, in cooperation with the commission, may
2 adopt administrative rules pursuant to chapter 17A necessary
3 to accomplish the purpose of the commission.

4 Sec. 5. NEW SECTION. 15.225 TERMINATION.

5 The Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial commission shall
6 dissolve by December 31, 2007.

7 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
8 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill creates an Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial
11 commission and fund.

12 The bill establishes an Iowa Lewis and Clark bicentennial
13 commission within the department of economic development which
14 shall be chartered and operated as a nonprofit corporation for
15 purposes of coordinating and promoting the observance of this
16 state's bicentennial commemoration of the Lewis and Clark
17 expedition. The bill provides that the commission shall be
18 composed of seven members consisting of the director of the
19 department of cultural affairs, the division administrator of
20 the division of tourism within the department of economic
21 development, the division administrator of the parks,
22 recreation, and preserves division within the department of
23 natural resources, and the division administrator of the
24 historical division within the department of cultural affairs.
25 The bill provides that the remaining three members shall be
26 appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by the
27 senate. The bill provides that the members appointed by the
28 governor shall have an interest or expertise in the history of
29 the Lewis and Clark expedition and at least two of the members
30 shall be members of an Indian tribe encountered by the Lewis
31 and Clark expedition.

32 The bill provides that the commission may cooperate with
33 national, regional, state, and local events promoting the
34 bicentennial; plan, assist, coordinate, or conduct
35 bicentennial events; engage in fund-raising activities,

1 including revenue-earning enterprises and the solicitation of
 2 grants, gifts, and donations; promote public education
 3 concerning the Lewis and Clark expedition; coordinate
 4 interagency participation in the observation and work with
 5 appropriate federal entities such as the national park
 6 service, the United States forest service, and the United
 7 States army; appoint various local and regional advisory
 8 committees; and perform any other related duties.

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 10 fund is established as a separate fund in the state treasury
 11 under the control of the commission and that the assets of the
 12 fund shall be used by the commission for carrying out the
 13 purposes of the commission.

14 The bill provides that the Iowa Lewis and Clark
 15 bicentennial commission terminates on December 31, 2007.

16 The bill takes effect upon enactment.

FISCAL NOTE**

A fiscal note for House File 2424 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2424 creates an Iowa Lewis and Clark Bicentennial Commission to coordinate and promote the observance of the Lewis and Clark expedition's bicentennial. The Bill also creates a fund to receive any appropriations or other funds made available to the Commission. The Commission is dissolved on December 31, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT

It is estimated the Commission will require \$500,000 per year for 1.00 FTE position, support expenditures, and grants to assist local attractions. However, the Bill does not provide funding for the Commission.

An increase in tourism due to the promotional activities of the Commission should generate additional State sales tax income. The Department of Economic Development estimates the increased sales tax receipts will exceed the annual funding required for the Commission.
