A BILL FOR

1 An Act repealing a provision authorizing the raising of an
2 additional enrichment amount to fund asbestos removal
3 projects.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 279.52, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 The board of directors may pay the actual cost of an
4 asbestos project from any funds in the general fund of the
5 district, funds received from the physical plant and equipment
6 levy, ~~funds-received-from-the-additional-enrichment-amount-for~~
7 ~~an-asbestos-project-in-section-279-53~~, or moneys obtained
8 through a federal asbestos loan program, to be repaid from any
9 of the funds specified in this subsection over a three-year
10 period.

11 Sec. 2. Section 298.14, unnumbered paragraphs 1 and 2,
12 Code 1999, are amended to read as follows:

13 For each fiscal year, the cumulative total of the percents
14 of surtax approved by the board of directors of a school
15 district and collected by the department of revenue and
16 finance under sections 257.21, 257.29, ~~279-54~~, and 298.2, and
17 the enrichment surtax under section 442.15, Code 1989, and an
18 income surtax collected by a political subdivision under
19 chapter 422D, shall not exceed twenty percent.

20 A school district income surtax fund is created in the
21 office of treasurer of state. Income surtaxes collected by
22 the department of revenue and finance under sections 257.21,
23 257.29, ~~279-54~~, and 298.2 and section 442.15, Code 1989, shall
24 be deposited in the school district income surtax fund to the
25 credit of each school district. A separate accounting of each
26 surtax, by school district, shall be maintained.

27 Sec. 3. Sections 279.53 and 279.54, Code 1999, are
28 repealed.

29 **EXPLANATION**

30 This bill provides for the repeal of provisions authorizing
31 the raising of an additional enrichment amount to fund
32 asbestos removal projects. Code sections 279.53 and 279.54
33 currently authorize the levy of an enrichment property tax or
34 combination of an enrichment property tax and income surtax
35 for up to a five-year period to school districts involved in

1 projects related to asbestos removal. The bill repeals these
 2 sections, and deletes a reference to this form of funding in
 3 Code section 279.52. Asbestos removal projects would continue
 4 to be able to be financed out of any funds in the general fund
 5 of a school district, funds received from the physical plant
 6 and equipment levy, or moneys obtained through a federal
 7 asbestos loan program, pursuant to Code section 279.52.

AN ACT

REPEALING A PROVISION AUTHORIZING THE RAISING OF AN ADDITIONAL ENRICHMENT AMOUNT TO FUND ASBESTOS REMOVAL PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 279.52, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:

The board of directors may pay the actual cost of an asbestos project from any funds in the general fund of the district, funds received from the physical plant and equipment levy, ~~funds received from the additional enrichment amount for an asbestos project in section 279.53~~, or moneys obtained through a federal asbestos loan program, to be repaid from any of the funds specified in this subsection over a three-year period.

Sec. 2. Section 298.14, unnumbered paragraphs 1 and 2, Code 1999, are amended to read as follows:

For each fiscal year, the cumulative total of the percents of surtax approved by the board of directors of a school district and collected by the department of revenue and finance under sections 257.21, 257.29, ~~279.54~~, and 298.2, and the enrichment surtax under section 442.15, Code 1989, and an income surtax collected by a political subdivision under chapter 422D, shall not exceed twenty percent.

A school district income surtax fund is created in the office of treasurer of state. Income surtaxes collected by the department of revenue and finance under sections 257.21, 257.29, ~~279.54~~, and 298.2 and section 442.15, Code 1989, shall be deposited in the school district income surtax fund to the credit of each school district. A separate accounting of each surtax, by school district, shall be maintained.
