1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. There is appropriated  
2 from the general fund of the state to the department of  
3 education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and  
4 ending June 30, 2001, the following amount, or so much thereof  
5 as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

6 For school districts to provide direct services to the most  
7 at-risk senior high school students enrolled in school  
8 districts through direct intervention by a "jobs for America's  
9 graduates" specialist:
