2 1. Page 1, by inserting after line 6 the
3 following:

4 "Sec. ____ Section 372.14, subsection 1, Code
5 1999, is amended to read as follows:

6 1. The mayor is the chief executive officer of the
7 city and presiding officer of the council. However,
8 the mayor shall not appoint, employ, or discharge
9 officers or employees without the approval of the
10 council. Except for the supervisory duties which have
11 been delegated by law to a city manager, the mayor
12 shall supervise all city officers and departments."

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 364.25 POLICE PROTECTION --
2 CITIES UNDER ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED POPULATION.

3 A city having a population of less than one thousand two
4 hundred may provide or discontinue police protection within
5 its jurisdiction or may provide for police protection by
6 intergovernmental agreement.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides that a city having a population of less
9 than 1,200 may discontinue police protection or may provide
10 for police protection by intergovernmental agreement.
