1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS SECURITY ANALYSIS --  
 2 REPORT. The department of corrections, in consultation with  
 3 the board of parole, shall conduct a study concerning safety  
 4 and security issues for the employees of the central office of  
 5 the department and of the board of parole and its employees.  
 6 In conducting its analysis, the department shall consider and  
 7 make recommendations concerning possible security improvements  
 8 and other measures that, if implemented, would improve the  
 9 safety and security of employees of the central office of the  
 10 department and of the board of parole and its employees, as  
 11 well as the cost of such improvements or measures. The  
 12 department shall submit a report concerning the results of its  
 13 findings and recommendations to the general assembly by  
 14 January 1, 2001.

EXPLANATION

15  
 16 This bill requires the department of corrections to conduct  
 17 a study concerning safety and security for employees of the  
 18 central office of the department and the board of parole, and  
 19 to report to the general assembly concerning its findings and  
 20 recommendations by January 1, 2001.
