1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 10A.403 INVESTIGATORS -- PEACE 2 OFFICER STATUS.

Investigators of the division shall have the powers and authority of peace officers when acting within the scope of their responsibilities to conduct investigations as specified in section 10A.402, subsection 7. An investigator shall not carry a weapon to perform responsibilities as described in this section unless authorized to do so by the director. If the director authorizes an investigator to carry a weapon, the director shall specify the circumstances under which the

11 investigator is authorized to do so.
12 EXPLANATION

This bill provides that investigators employed within the investigations division of the department of inspections and appeals shall have the power and authority of a peace officer while conducting an investigation including benefit assistance programs described in section 10A.402, subsection 7. Peace officer status permits a person to, among other things, issue misdemeanor summons, petition for a search warrant, and make an arrest. The bill further provides that an investigator shall not carry a weapon unless the director of the department of inspections and appeals authorizes the use under specific circumstances.
