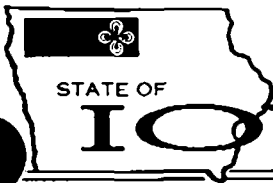

Subject: Proposed Department Legislation

Attached is a departmental proposed bill to delete language from Iowa Code section 455D.9A requiring the department to develop rules defining baled solid waste and identifying proper methods of disposal.

The law - 455D.9A - already prohibits disposal of baled solid waste at a landfill. "Beginning January 1, 1992, a person shall not dispose of baled solid waste at a sanitary landfill and a sanitary landfill shall not accept baled solid waste for final disposal. Solid waste which is baled on-site may be disposed of at the sanitary landfill." There is nothing to write rules on.
