**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the composition of regional advisory boards of  
2 the workforce development board.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 450

1 Section 1. Section 84A.4, subsection 1, Code 1999, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. A regional advisory board shall be established in each  
4 service delivery area as defined in section 84B.2. The  
5 members of the board shall be appointed by the governor,  
6 consistent with the requirements of federal law and in  
7 consultation with chief elected officials within the region.  
8 Chief elected officials responsible for recommendations for  
9 board membership shall include, but are not limited to, county  
10 elected officials, municipal elected officials, and community  
11 college directors. The membership of each board shall provide  
12 for equal representation of business and labor and shall  
13 include a county elected official, a city official, a  
14 representative of a school district, and a representative of a  
15 community college. In addition, the membership of each board  
16 shall include, as nonvoting members, elder workers or  
17 representatives from organizations concerned with the elderly,  
18 persons with disabilities or representatives from  
19 organizations concerned with the disabled, and other persons  
20 or representatives of organizations as the chief elected  
21 officials within the region determine to be appropriate.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill provides that the membership of regional advisory  
24 boards contain, as nonvoting members, elderly workers or  
25 representatives from organizations concerned with the elderly,  
26 persons with disabilities or representatives from  
27 organizations concerned with the disabled, and other persons  
28 or representatives the chief elected officials of the region  
29 deems appropriate.

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
