 6 successfully completed the probation shall only be
 7 disseminated by the department to a criminal or juvenile
 8 justice agency, or to the person who is the subject of the
 9 criminal history data or the person's attorney,-or-to-another
10 person-with-a-signed-release-from-the-person-who-is-the
11 subject-of-the-criminal-history-data-authorizing-the
12 requesting-person-access-to-the-criminal-history-data.

      This bill amends Code section 692.2, pertaining to the
15 release of criminal history data.

      The bill provides that a person who successfully completes
17 probation following a deferred judgment and the person's
18 attorney shall only have access to any criminal history data
19 that pertains to the underlying criminal offense and the
20 deferred judgment.

      Existing law permits access to criminal history data if a
22 person has written authorization from the person who received
23 the deferred judgment.

      A person who receives a deferred judgment is entitled to
25 have the court's criminal record expunded pursuant to Code
26 section 907.9, subsection 4.
