**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the tuition charged of nonresidents at the  
2 institutions of higher learning under the control of the state  
3 board of regents.

1 Section 1. Section 262.9, Code 1999, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 30. Cause the institutions of higher  
4 learning under its control to permit a nonresident student to  
5 pay the resident tuition rate if the student's state of  
6 residence permits students who are residents of Iowa to pay  
7 the resident tuition rate at its state institutions of higher  
8 learning. Notwithstanding this subsection, the board may  
9 negotiate a reciprocal tuition agreement with another state  
10 for a different allocation of tuition rates.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill requires the state board of regents to cause the  
13 institutions of higher learning under its control to permit a  
14 nonresident student to pay the resident tuition rate if the  
15 student's state of residence permits students who are  
16 residents of Iowa to pay the resident tuition rate at its  
17 state institutions of higher learning. However, the bill  
18 authorizes the board to negotiate a reciprocal tuition  
19 agreement with another state for a different allocation of  
20 tuition rates.
