Section 137C.35, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2 1999, is amended to read as follows: A bed and breakfast inn is subject to regulation, 4 licensing, and inspection under this chapter, but separate 5 toilet and lavatory facilities shall not be required for each 6 guest room. Additionally, a bed and breakfast inn is exempt from fire safety rules adopted pursuant to section 100.35 and applicable to hotels, but is subject to fire safety rules
