## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to a watershed protection task force and creating

a watershed protection program and a watershed protection 2

3 account within the water protection fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 161C.7 WATERSHED PROTECTION.
- The department of agriculture and land stewardship
- 3 shall initiate and coordinate the establishment of a watershed
- 4 protection task force and provide staffing assistance to the
- 5 task force. It is the intent of the general assembly that the
- 6 task force include representatives of the department of
- 7 agriculture and land stewardship, the department of natural
- 8 resources, the emergency management division of the department
- 9 of public defense, county conservation boards, soil and water
- 10 conservation districts, and any other appropriate
- 11 stakeholders. The task force shall study the condition of
- 12 watershed protection in the state and provide recommendations
- 13 to the department of agriculture and land stewardship
- 14 regarding soil conservation, water quality protection, flood
- 15 control, and other natural resource conservation issues. The
- 16 task force shall submit recommendations to the department by
- 17 January 1 of each year through January 1, 2001.
- 18 2. The department of agriculture and land stewardship
- 19 shall implement and administer a watershed protection program.
- 20 A soil and water conservation district, in cooperation with
- 21 state agencies, local units of government, and private
- 22 organizations, may submit an application for assistance to the
- 23 department which provides a strategy for protecting soil,
- 24 water quality, and other natural resources, and improving
- 25 flood control in the watershed. Upon approval of an
- 26 application, the department may provide a grant to the soil
- 27 and water conservation district for purposes of carrying out
- 28 the strategy provided in the application.
- 29 3. A watershed protection account is created within the
- 30 water protection fund created in section 161C.4. Moneys
- 31 credited to the account shall be distributed under the
- 32 watershed protection program.
- 33 4. Administrative rules used for water quality protection
- 34 projects under the water protection fund shall be used to
- 35 administer the watershed protection program.

1 EXPLANATION This bill provides that the department of agriculture and 2 3 land stewardship shall establish a watershed protection task 4 force consisting of all appropriate stakeholders. 5 provides that the task force shall study the condition of 6 watershed protection in the state and make recommendations to 7 the department by January 1 of each year through January 1, 8 2001, regarding soil conservation, water quality protection, 9 flood control, and other natural resource conservation issues. The bill provides that the department shall implement and 10 11 administer a watershed protection program to provide grants to 12 soil and water conservation districts. In order to receive a 13 grant under the program, a soil and water conservation 14 district, in cooperation with state agencies, local units of 15 government, and private organizations, must have an 16 application approved by the department which includes a 17 strategy to improve soil, water quality, and other natural 18 resources, and improving flood control in the watershed. 19 bill provides that the moneys received under the program are 20 to be used for purposes of carrying out the strategy set forth 21 in the application to the department. The bill creates a watershed protection account within the 23 water protection fund. The bill provides that moneys credited 24 to the account shall be distributed under the watershed 25 protection program. The bill provides that the watershed 26 protection program shall be administered by the same rules 27 used for water quality protection projects under the water 28 protection fund. 29 30 31 32 33 34

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
