1 Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS -- SERVICES FOR ELDERS.

2 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
3 state, in addition to any other appropriation for the purposes  
4 designated, to the department of elder affairs for the fiscal  
5 year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000, the  
6 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the  
7 following purposes:

- 8 a. For the retired senior volunteers program:
- 9 ..... \$ 215,000
- 10 b. For Alzheimer's chapters:
- 11 ..... \$ 115,000
- 12 c. For mental health outreach:
- 13 ..... \$ 25,000
- 14 d. For general elderly services:
- 15 ..... \$ 1,195,408
- 16 e. For statewide case management:
- 17 ..... \$ 3,000,000
- 18 f. For adult day care:
- 19 ..... \$ 350,000
- 20 g. For care review support:
- 21 ..... \$ 130,000

22 The funding appropriated under this subsection shall be  
23 allocated to the area agencies on aging and shall not be  
24 reduced by the state by any costs of administering or  
25 allocating the funds and shall not require the development of  
26 any new programs for receipt of the funds.

27 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
28 state, in addition to any other moneys appropriated for the  
29 purposes designated, to the Iowa department of public health  
30 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June  
31 30, 2000, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is  
32 necessary, for the purposes designated:

- 33 a. For the public health nursing program to be targeted
- 34 for home nursing visits for elders:
- 35 ..... \$ 2,637,465

1 b. For the home care aide/chore program to be used for  
2 homemaker, home-health, and chore program services for elders:  
3 ..... \$ 9,016,052

4 c. For the senior health program:  
5 ..... \$ 801,337

6 Moneys appropriated under this subsection shall not be  
7 reduced by the state by any costs of administering the funds  
8 and shall not require the development of any new programs for  
9 receipt of the funds.

EXPLANATION

This bill provides for appropriations from the general fund, in addition to any other general fund appropriation made for the purposes designated, to the department of elder affairs for the retired senior volunteers program, Alzheimer's chapters, mental health outreach, general elderly services, statewide case management, adult day care and care review support; and to the Iowa department of public health for the public health nursing program, the home care aide program, and the Iowa senior health program. Moneys appropriated are not to be reduced by the state for costs of administrating the funds and are not to require the development of any new programs for receipt of the funds.
