- 3. The average monthly noncommercial internet access charge is \$20.
- 4. Business purchases of internet access services are approximately one-half of residential purchases of internet access services.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal effect of exempting internet access charges from the sales tax is an estimated reduction in General Fund revenues compared to current law of between \$5.5 and \$6.0 million annually. Due to the enforcement of current law, it is estimated that approximately \$2.0 million of tax liability is not being currently collected. This uncollected liability reduces the cash basis impact to \$3.5 to \$4.0 million annually.
