4 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Joint Resolution, being  
5 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This Joint Resolution nullifies an administrative rule of  
8 the secretary of state's office applicable to preparation of a  
9 summary describing a constitutional amendment or statewide  
10 public measure. The rule to be nullified requires that the  
11 words describing the constitutional amendment or statewide  
12 public measure be prepared not less than 150 days before the  
13 election.

14 The Joint Resolution is effective upon enactment.
