**HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION**

1 A Joint Resolution relating to the designation of educational  
2 facilities at the State Training School as the Arlene Dayhoff  
3 Educational Complex.

4 WHEREAS, it is customary to recognize exceptional public  
5 service benefiting the citizens of Iowa by naming public  
6 buildings in honor of individuals; and

7 WHEREAS, the new educational and recreational facilities under  
8 construction at the state training school during 1999, 2000, and  
9 2001, replace buildings that were more than one hundred years  
10 old; and

11 WHEREAS, Arlene H. Dayhoff recognized the important role of  
12 good educational and recreational facilities in maintaining the  
13 quality of the state training school's work with this state's  
14 most troubled youth and worked tirelessly for approval of new  
15 facilities; and

16 WHEREAS, Arlene H. Dayhoff has the distinction of serving  
17 during 1987-1997 as Chairperson of the Council on Human Services,  
18 the primary policymaking body for the Department of Human  
19 Services, and having the longest tenure of anyone in that office;

21 WHEREAS, Arlene H. Dayhoff is known for her active life in

1 service activity with her twenty-three years of employment in the  
2 field of nursing and as a volunteer and board member with many  
3 human services and health endeavors, including St. Luke's  
4 Hospital and Hospital Foundation, Iowa Commission for the Blind,  
5 American Red Cross, Linn County Association for Mental Health,  
6 and Linn County Retarded Citizens, and has been nationally  
7 recognized for her leadership by the National Governors'  
8 Association distinguished service award; and

9 WHEREAS, following her tenure on the Council on Human  
10 Services, Arlene H. Dayhoff has continued her commitment to  
11 troubled children by serving as Co-chairperson of the Legislative  
12 Council's Child Welfare Work Group from the Work Group's creation  
13 in November 1997 through the present time; and

14 WHEREAS, it is fitting to recognize Arlene H. Dayhoff's many  
15 contributions to improving the lives of children with the  
16 dedication of the new educational and recreational facilities at  
17 the state training school in her name; NOW THEREFORE,

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

6 educational complex in recognition of Arlene Dayhoff and the

11 recreational facilities to be dedicated in the spring of 2001  
12 at the State Training School shall be named the Arlene Dayhoff  
13 Educational Complex.
