HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution relating to the designation of a cottage at  
2 the state training school as the Corbett-Miller cottage and  
3 providing an effective date.  
4 WHEREAS, it is customary to recognize exceptional public  
5 service and leadership benefiting the citizens of Iowa by naming  
6 public buildings in honor of individuals; and  
7 WHEREAS, the new cottage under construction at the state  
8 training school during 1999 and 2000 is the first new living unit  
9 to be developed in more than thirty years and is to be dedicated  
10 in the spring of 2000, and would not have been developed without  
11 the efforts and leadership of Ron J. Corbett, former Speaker of  
12 the House of Representatives of the Iowa General Assembly, and  
13 Tom Miller, Attorney General of the State of Iowa; and  
14 WHEREAS, Ron J. Corbett of Cedar Rapids was first elected to  
15 the General Assembly in 1986 and held numerous positions of  
16 leadership during his term in office, including service as an  
17 assistant minority party floor leader, chairperson of the House

1 Committee on Appropriations, and Speaker of the House for five  
2 years, and throughout these years of service maintained a strong  
3 commitment to improving the quality of services directed to  
4 juveniles and the condition of the state training school; and

5 WHEREAS, Tom Miller of Dubuque has served as Attorney General  
6 from 1978 to 1990 and from 1995 to the present time, has also  
7 served the public in other capacities at the federal and local  
8 government levels, established the ongoing Attorney General's  
9 Task Force on Juvenile Crime, and taken other actions to improve  
10 public policy relating to juvenile crime in general and the state  
11 training school in particular; and

12 WHEREAS, both former Speaker Corbett and Attorney General  
13 Miller have worked to develop a spectrum of services for troubled  
14 juveniles ranging from assistance at home in appropriate cases to  
15 more structured settings for juveniles with more serious  
16 problems, and saw the need to develop additional secure beds at  
17 the state training school to address the needs of juveniles with  
18 the most serious problems; NOW THEREFORE,

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 That the cottage to be dedicated in the spring of 2000 at  
2 the state training school in Eldora, Iowa, be named the  
3 Corbett-Miller cottage in honor of the former Speaker of the  
4 House of Representatives of the Iowa General Assembly, Ron J.  
5 Corbett, and the Honorable Tom Miller, Attorney General of the  
6 State of Iowa; and that an appropriate commemorative plaque be  
7 placed near the entrance of the cottage in recognition of Ron  
8 J. Corbett and Tom Miller and the outstanding contributions  
9 they have made to the state training school and the State of  
10 Iowa in their public and private service.

11 This joint resolution, being deemed of immediate  
12 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This joint resolution provides that the cottage to be  
15 dedicated in the spring of 2000 at the state training school  
16 shall be named the Corbett-Miller cottage.

17 The joint resolution takes effect upon enactment.
