A House Resolution relating to fully funding the senior-living program.

WHEREAS, Senate File 2193, as enacted by the 2000 Session of the Iowa General Assembly and approved by the Governor of the State of Iowa, establishes the parameters for the development of a comprehensive long-term care system that is consumer-directed, and provides a balance between the alternatives of institutionally and noninstitutionally provided services; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Human Services has submitted a state plan to the Health Care Financing Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services to effectuate such a comprehensive long-term care system; and

WHEREAS, implementation of such a comprehensive system is contingent upon federal funding of the state plan as submitted; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, That the Iowa congressional delegation take necessary action to encourage the United States Health Care Financing Administration to fully fund the state plan as submitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to all members of Iowa's congressional delegation.
