          This bill strikes a provision from the Code that requires
  1 23 county civil service employees, including deputies in the
  1 24 sheriff's office, to take a leave of absence when such
  1 25 employees are candidates for paid elective office in a primary
  1 26 or general election. If the bill is enacted, Code section
  1 27 55.4 will apply to county civil service employees. That
  1 28 section allows a public employee who is a candidate for
  1 29 elective office to request a leave of absence for a period
  1 30 commencing 30 days before a contested election and ending
  1 31 after the day following the election. The leave of absence
  1 32 shall be automatically granted upon request.
