- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 56.5B LIMITATIONS ON 2 CONTRIBUTIONS.
- 3 l. A political committee shall not make contributions
- 4 that, during any election campaign cycle, in the aggregate
- 5 exceed the following:
- 6 a. Two thousand dollars to any candidate or candidate's
- 7 committee for a statewide office.
- 8 b. Five hundred dollars to any candidate or candidate's
