1 Section 1. Section 321.324A, subsection 1, Code 1999, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 For purposes of this section, "funeral procession" 4 means a procession of motor vehicles accompanying the body of 5 a deceased person during daylight hours which is being 6 escorted by a vehicle continually displaying flashing its 7 emergency signal lamps flashing-simultaneously and using 8 lighted head lamps and identifying flags, and keeping all 9 other motor vehicles with lighted-head-lamps flashing 10 emergency signal lamps in close formation. Section 321.423, subsection 2, Code 1999, is 11 Sec. 2. 12 amended by adding the following new paragraph: 13 NEW PARAGRAPH. h. On a motor vehicle which is part of a 14 funeral procession pursuant to section 321.324A. 15 EXPLANATION This bill amends Code section 321.324A to provide that 16 17 motor vehicles taking part in a funeral procession shall use 18 flashing emergency signal lamps. Currently, such motor 19 vehicles are directed to use lighted headlamps. 20 The bill also amends Code section 321.423, which regulates 21 the use of flashing lights on motor vehicles, to provide that 22 motor vehicles taking part in a funeral procession are 23 exempted from the prohibition on flashing lights on or in 24 motor vehicles. 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
