Section 1. NATIONAL WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL APPROPRIATION.
Notwithstanding section 8.57, subsection 5, paragraph "c,"
there is appropriated from the rebuild Iowa infrastructure
fund to the commission of veterans affairs for the fiscal year
beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, the
following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
used for the purpose designated:

12 The commission of veterans affairs shall not make a 13 contribution of any of the funds appropriated in this section 14 unless either of the following conditions has been met:

Notwithstanding section 8.33, if the commission of veterans affairs has not made the contribution provided for in this section by June 30, 2002, the moneys appropriated in this section shall revert to the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund. Section 8.39 shall not apply to the appropriation in this section.

EXPLANATION

This bill makes an appropriation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, to the commission of veterans affairs to be contributed to the World War II memorial fund for the construction of a national World War II memorial in Washington, D.C. The commission of veterans affairs shall not make such contribution unless the
