A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the commission of veterans
2 affairs for a contribution toward the construction of a
3 national World War II memorial.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NATIONAL WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL APPROPRIATION.
2 Notwithstanding section 8.57, subsection 5, paragraph "c,"
3 there is appropriated from the rebuild Iowa infrastructure
4 fund to the commission of veterans affairs for the fiscal year
5 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, the
6 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
7 used for the purpose designated:

8 For a contribution to the World War II memorial fund for
9 funding the construction of a national World War II memorial
10 in Washington, D.C.:

11 \$ 278,000

12 The commission of veterans affairs shall not make a
13 contribution of any of the funds appropriated in this section
14 unless either of the following conditions has been met:

15 1. The United States secretary of the interior has issued
16 a construction permit for construction of the national World
17 War II memorial.

18 2. The United States secretary of the interior has not
19 issued a construction permit as provided in subsection 1, but
20 the commission of veterans affairs has determined there is
21 substantial evidence of sufficient funding available for
22 construction of the national World War II memorial.

23 Notwithstanding section 8.33, if the commission of veterans
24 affairs has not made the contribution provided for in this
25 section by June 30, 2002, the moneys appropriated in this
26 section shall revert to the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund.

27 Section 8.39 shall not apply to the appropriation in this
28 section.

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill makes an appropriation for the fiscal year
31 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, to the
32 commission of veterans affairs to be contributed to the World
33 War II memorial fund for the construction of a national World
34 War II memorial in Washington, D.C. The commission of
35 veterans affairs shall not make such contribution unless the

1 U.S. secretary of the interior has issued a construction
2 permit for construction of the memorial or the commission of
3 veterans affairs has determined there is substantial evidence
4 of sufficient funding available for construction of the
5 memorial.
