1 Section 1. Section 91D.1, subsection 1, paragraphs a and
2 d, Code 1999, are amended to read as follows:

3 a. The hourly wage stated in the federal minimum wage law,
4 pursuant to 29 U.S.C. § 206, shall be increased to ~~\$3.85~~ \$6.15
5 on January 1 of ~~1990~~ 2001, ~~\$4.25-on-January-1-of-1991~~, and
6 ~~\$4.65~~ \$7.15 on January 1 of ~~1992~~ 2002.

7 d. An employer is not required to pay an employee the
8 applicable minimum wage provided in paragraph "a" until the
9 employee has completed ninety calendar days of employment with
10 the employer. ~~An-employee-who-has-completed-ninety-calendar~~
11 ~~days-of-employment-with-the-employer-prior-to-January-1-of~~
12 ~~1990,1991,or1992,shall-earn-the-applicable-hourly-minimum~~
13 ~~wage.~~ An employer shall pay an employee who has not completed
14 ninety calendar days of employment with the employer an hourly
15 wage of at least ~~\$3.35-as-of-January-1-of-1990~~, ~~\$3.85~~ \$5.15 as
16 of January 1 of ~~1991~~ 2001, and ~~\$4.25~~ \$6.15 as of January 1 of
17 ~~1992~~ 2002.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill raises the state's hourly minimum wage to \$6.15
20 beginning January 1, 2001, and to \$7.15 beginning January 1,
21 2002. The hourly minimum wage for employees serving a 90-day
22 training period is raised to \$5.15 on January 1, 2001, and
23 \$6.15 on January 1, 2002.

24 The federal minimum wage is currently \$5.15.
