Upon the transfer of ownership of an all-terrain vehicle or snowmobile, the owner shall complete the form on the back of a the current registration certificate and shall deliver it to the purchaser or transferee at the time of delivering the allterrain vehicle or snowmobile. If-an-all-terrain-vehicle-or enowmobile-is-stored-by-the-transferor-pursuant-to-section 3216-4-at-the-time-of-transfery-the-transferor-shall-provide the-transferee-with-a-copy-of-the-affidavit-filed-with-the county-recorder-pursuant-to-section-3216-4-at-the-time-of delivering-the-all-terrain-vehicle-or-snowmobile: The purchaser or transferee shall, within five days of transfer, file a new application form with the county recorder with a fee of one dollar and the writing fee, and a transfer of number shall be awarded in the same manner as provided in an original registration. 483A.10 ISSUANCE OF LICENSES.

The licenses issued pursuant to this chapter shall be issued by the department,—the—county—recorders, or the license depositaries as specified by rules of the commission. A county recorder may issue licenses subject to the rules of the department. The rules shall include the application procedures as necessary. The licenses shall show the cost of the license and the writing fee. A person authorized to issue
