A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the utilization of budget enrollment in
2 determining gifted and talented program funding, and providing
3 an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 257.46, subsection 2, Code Supplement
2 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 2. The remaining portion of the budget shall be funded by
4 the thirty-eight dollar increase in allowable growth for the
5 school budget year beginning July 1, 1999, ~~increased-by-the~~
6 ~~growth-of-the-regular-program-district-cost-each-year~~
7 multiplied by a district's budget enrollment. The thirty-
8 eight dollar increase for the school budget year beginning
9 July 1, 1999, shall increase in subsequent years by each
10 year's state percent of growth. School districts shall
11 annually report the amount expended for a gifted and talented
12 program to the department of education. The proportion of a
13 school district's budget which corresponds to the thirty-eight
14 dollar increase in allowable growth for the school budget year
15 beginning July 1, 1999, added to the amount in subsection 1,
16 shall be utilized exclusively for a school district's talented
17 ~~and gifted~~ and talented program.

18 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
19 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that the \$38 increase in allowable
22 growth for the school budget year beginning July 1, 1999, will
23 be multiplied by a school district's budget enrollment in
24 determining the amount of state funding provided for gifted
25 and talented programs pursuant to Code section 257.46. By
26 utilizing budget enrollment, additional enrollment generated
27 by special education weighting will not be included for gifted
28 and talented funding purposes.

29 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
