A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the regulation of controlled substances and
2 precursors to controlled substances.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 124.204, subsection 4, Code 1999, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. ad. Alpha-ethyltryptamine. Some trade or
4 other names: etryptamine; Monase; a-ethyl-1H-indole-3-
5 ethanamine; 3-(2-aminobutyl)indole; alpha-ET; and AET.

6 NEW PARAGRAPH. ae. 4-Bromo-2,5-dimethoxyphenethylamine.
7 Some trade or other names: 2-(4-bromo-2,5-dimethoxyphenyl)-1-
8 aminoethane; alpha-desmethyl DOB; 2C-B, Nexus.

9 Sec. 2. Section 124.204, subsection 6, Code 1999, is
10 amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

11 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. Aminorex. Some other names:
12 aminoxaphen; 2-amino-5-phenyl-2-oxazoline; 4,5-dihydro-5-
13 phenyl-2-oxazolamine.

14 NEW PARAGRAPH. g. Methcathinone. Some other names: 2-
15 (methylamino)-propiophenone; alpha-(methylamino)propiophenone;
16 2-(methylamino)-1-phenylpropan-1-one; alpha-N-
17 methylaminopropiophenone; monomethylpropion; ephedrone; N-
18 methylcathinone; methylcathinone; AL-464; AL-422; AL-463; and
19 UR1432.

20 Sec. 3. Section 124.204, subsection 9, paragraphs c, d,
21 and e, Code 1999, are amended by striking the paragraphs.

22 Sec. 4. Section 124.206, subsection 2, paragraph a,
23 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1999, is amended to read as
24 follows:

25 Opium and opiate, and any salt, compound, derivative, or
26 preparation of opium or opiate, excluding apomorphine,

12 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. HALLUCINOGENIC SUBSTANCES. Dronabinol
13 (synthetic) in sesame oil and encapsulated in a soft gelatin
14 capsule in a United States Food and Drug Administration
15 approved product. Some other names for dronabinol: (6aR-
16 trans)-6a, 7, 8, 10a-tetrahydro-6, 6, 9-trimethyl-3-pentyl-6H-
17 dibenzo [b,d] pyran-1-ol, or (-)-delta-9-(trans)-
18 tetrahydrocannabinol.

19 Sec. 10. Section 124.210, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code
20 1999, is amended to read as follows:

1 Sec. 14. Section 124B.2, subsection 1, paragraphs a, c, g,
2 and i, Code 1999, are amended to read as follows:

4 c. Ephedrine, ~~its salts, optical isomers, and salts of~~
5 ~~optical isomers~~ Ethylamine and its salts.

6 g. N-acetylanthranilic acid, its esters, and its salts.

7 i. Phenylacetic acid, its esters, and its salts.

8 Sec. 15. Section 124B.2, subsection 1, Code 1999, is
9 amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

10 NEW PARAGRAPH. m. Methylamine and its salts.

11 NEW PARAGRAPH. n. Propionic anhydride.

12 NEW PARAGRAPH. o. Insosafrole.

13 NEW PARAGRAPH. p. Safrole.

14 NEW PARAGRAPH. q. Piperonal.

15 NEW PARAGRAPH. r. N-methylephedrine, its salts, optical
16 isomers, and salts of optical isomers.

17 NEW PARAGRAPH. s. N-methylpseudoephedrine, its salts,
18 optical isomers, and salts of optical isomers.

19 NEW PARAGRAPH. t. Hydriodic acid.

20 NEW PARAGRAPH. u. Benzaldehyde.

21 NEW PARAGRAPH. v. Nitroethane.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill relates to the regulation of controlled
24 substances and precursors to controlled substances.

25 The amendments to Code chapter 124 provide for uniformity
26 between the Iowa uniform controlled substances Act, contained
27 in Iowa Code chapter 124, and the federal Uniform Controlled
28 Substances Act. The bill adds substances to Schedules I, II,
29 III, and IV, and moves synthetic dronabinol from Schedule II
30 to Schedule III, and places substances previously identified
31 under Schedule I as other materials into the specific
32 categories of hallucinogenic substances and stimulants.

33 The amendments to Code chapter 124B expand the list of
34 precursor substances to include all list I chemicals
35 identified in the federal Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

1 The bill also removes ephedrine from the list of precursor
2 substances in Code section 124B.2 due to the reclassification
3 of ephedrine as a controlled substance in Code chapter 124.

2 1. Page 2, by inserting after line 35 the
3 following:

4 "Sec. ____ . Section 124.212, subsection 5, Code
5 1999, is amended to read as follows:

6 5. EPHEDRINE. Unless specifically excepted in
7 paragraph "b", or "c", or listed in another schedule,
8 any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which
9 contains any quantity of the following substance,
10 including its salts, optical isomers, and salts of
11 such optical isomers:

12 a. Ephedrine.

13 b. The following drug products containing
14 ephedrine, its salts, optical isomers, and salts of
15 such optical isomers are excepted from this schedule,
16 if they may lawfully be sold over the counter without
17 a prescription under the federal Food, Drug and
18 Cosmetic Act; are labeled and marketed in a manner
19 consistent with the pertinent over-the-counter
20 tentative final or final monograph; are manufactured
21 and distributed for legitimate medicinal use in a
22 manner that reduces or eliminates the likelihood of
23 abuse; and are not marketed, advertised, or labeled
24 for the indication of stimulation, mental alertness,
25 weight loss, muscle enhancement, appetite control, or
26 energy:

27 (1) Solid oral dosage forms, including soft
28 gelatin capsules, that combine active ingredients in
29 the following range for each dosage unit of not less
30 than twelve and five-tenths milligrams but not more
31 than twenty-five milligrams of ephedrine and not less
32 than four hundred milligrams of guaifenesin packaged
33 in blister packs of not more than two tablets per
34 blister.

35 (2) Anorectal preparations containing less than
36 five percent ephedrine.

37 c. Drug products are also excepted from this
38 schedule if the drug products are not otherwise
39 prohibited by any other law and are naturally
40 occurring ephedrine alkaloids or their salts, isomers,
41 or salts of isomers, or a combination of these
42 substances that are contained in a matrix of organic
43 material and do not exceed fifteen percent of the
44 total weight of the natural product."
