8 an organ donor registry. Grants shall be made based upon the

11 an organ donor registry.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill provides that up to 20 percent of the moneys in
14 the anatomical gift public awareness and transplantation fund
15 may be expended in the form of grants to state agencies or

17 projects, as is currently allowed, but also to develop and
18 maintain an organ donor registry.
