1 Section 1. Section 455B.104, Code 1999, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. By January 15 of each year, the
4 department shall submit a report to the general assembly
5 relating to the status of environmental violations for which
6 some action by the department has been initiated during the
7 previous calendar year. The report shall be filed pursuant to
8 section 7A.11. The majority leader and minority leader of the
9 senate shall transmit copies of the report to the chairs and
10 ranking members of all standing committees in the senate which
11 consider legislation regarding the environment and natural
12 resources, and the speaker of the house and minority leader of
13 the house shall transmit copies of the report to the chairs
14 and ranking members of all standing committees in the house
15 which consider legislation regarding the environment and
16 natural resources. The report shall include, but not be
17 limited to, all of the following:

18 a. A report on hazardous conditions reported to the
19 department which shall include, but not be limited to, all of
20 the following:

21 (1) Identification of the number of hazardous conditions
22 reported to the department during each month of the previous
23 calendar year.

24 (2) Categorization of the hazardous conditions reported by
25 the type of incident involved during each month of the
26 previous calendar year.

27 (3) Comparison by month and by categorization of the
28 number of hazardous conditions reported during the previous
29 calendar year and the calendar year prior to the previous
30 calendar year.

31 b. A report on the status of all enforcement actions taken
32 during the previous calendar year. The report shall include,
33 but not be limited to, all of the following in regard to each
34 enforcement action taken:

35 (1) The name and location of the party against whom the

1 action was taken.

2 (2) The program categorization.

3 (3) The violation alleged.

4 (4) The action taken.

5 (5) The date enforcement action was taken.

6 c. A summary of all administrative penalties which are due
7 to the department or have been appealed, all penalties which
8 are due to the department or have been appealed from cases
9 referred to the attorney general, and all penalties which were
10 paid during the previous calendar year. The summary shall
11 include, but not be limited to, all of the following in regard
12 to each penalty:

13 (1) The name and location of the party paying or appealing
14 the penalty.

15 (2) The program categorization.

16 (3) The penalty amount due, paid, or appealed.

17 (4) The date the penalty is due, if applicable, or was
18 paid.

19 d. A report on the current status of all pending cases
20 referred to the attorney general. The report shall include,
21 but not be limited to, all of the following in regard to each
22 case:

23 (1) The name and location of the party against whom action
24 was taken.

25 (2) The program categorization.

26 (3) The violation alleged.

27 (4) The action taken by the department.

28 (5) The current status of the case.

29 e. A report on the current status of all pending contested
30 cases. The report shall include, but not be limited to, all
31 of the following in regard to each case:

32 (1) The name and location of the party against whom action
33 was taken.

34 (2) The program categorization.

35 (3) The violation alleged.

1 (4) The action taken by the department which is being
2 appealed.

3 (5) The current status of the case.

4 EXPLANATION

5 This bill requires the department of natural resources to
6 submit a report to the secretary of the senate, the chief
7 clerk of the house of representatives, and each caucus or
8 research staff director of the general assembly relating to
9 the status of environmental violations for which some action
10 by the department has been initiated. The report is to be
11 submitted by January 15 of each year. The bill provides that
12 copies of the report will be transmitted to the chairpersons
13 and ranking members of committees considering legislation on
14 the environment and natural resources in each house.

15 The bill provides that the report shall include all of the
16 following:

17 1. A report on hazardous conditions reported to the
18 department.

19 2. A report on the status of all enforcement actions taken
20 during the previous calendar year.

21 3. A summary of all administrative penalties which are due
22 to the department or have been appealed, all penalties which
23 are due to the department or have been appealed from cases
24 referred to the attorney general, and all penalties which were
25 paid during the previous calendar year.

26 4. A report on the current status of all pending cases
27 referred to the attorney general.

28 5. A report on the current status of all pending contested
29 cases.
