1 Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 21, paragraph c, Code  
2 Supplement 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 c. A requirement that all school districts and accredited  
4 nonpublic schools annually report to the department and the  
5 local community the ~~district-wide~~ progress made in attaining  
6 student achievement goals on the academic and other core  
7 indicators and the ~~district-wide~~ progress made in attaining  
8 locally established student learning goals. Progress shall be  
9 reported by the school districts and accredited nonpublic  
10 schools by individual attendance center and the district as a  
11 whole. The school districts and accredited nonpublic schools  
12 shall demonstrate the use of multiple assessment measures in  
13 determining student achievement levels. The school districts  
14 and accredited nonpublic schools may report on other locally  
15 determined factors influencing student achievement. ~~The~~  
16 ~~school-districts-and-accredited-nonpublic-schools-shall-also~~  
17 ~~report-to-the-local-community-their-results-by-individual~~  
18 ~~attendance-center.~~

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill amends current Code language to require that the  
21 student achievement report that all school districts and  
22 accredited nonpublic schools must submit to the department and  
23 to their local communities, include the school district and  
24 accredited nonpublic school results by individual attendance  
25 center, as well as the districtwide results.
