A BILL FOR

1 An Act creating a new employment opportunity program and making
2 an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1	Section 1. NEW SECTION. 84A.10 NEW EMPLOYMENT
2	OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM.
3	The department of workforce development shall implement and
4	administer a new employment opportunity program to assist
5	individuals in underutilized segments of Iowa's workforce to
6	gain and retain employment. The program shall be designed to
7	complement existing employment and training programs by
8	providing additional flexibility and services that are often
9	needed by individuals in underutilized segments of the
10	workforce to gain and retain employment. Services provided
11	under the program may include, but are not limited to,
12	transportation costs, child care, health care, health care
13	insurance, on-the-job training, short-term basic education,
14	internships, mentoring, assisting businesses with compliance
15	issues related to the federal Americans with Disabilities Act
16	of 1990, and reducing perceived risks that cause these
17	populations to be underutilized. The department shall adopt
18	rules pursuant to chapter 17A to administer the program,
19	including rules relating to eligibility criteria.
20	Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
21	state to the department of workforce development for the
22	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001,
23	the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to
24	be used for the purpose designated:

28	EXPLANATION
29	This bill provides that the department of workforce
	development shall implement and administer a new employment
31	opportunity program designed to assist individuals in
32	underutilized segments of Iowa's workforce to gain and retain
