1 Section 1. Section 282.30, subsection 1, paragraph b,
2 unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1999, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 c. An area education agency shall not provide educational
5 services to a facility specified in paragraph "a" unless the
6 facility makes a request for educational services to the area
7 education agency by either of the following dates:

8 (1) December 1 of the school year prior to the beginning
9 of the school year for which the services are being requested.

10 (2) Ninety days prior to the beginning of the time for
11 which the services are being requested if the facility is a
12 newly established facility.

13 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE -- FACILITIES FOR 1999-2000 SCHOOL
14 YEAR. Section 1 of this Act, amending section 282.30 and
15 relating to educational services provided to a facility by an
16 area education agency, being deemed of immediate importance,
17 takes effect upon enactment. A facility described in section
18 282.30, subsection 1, paragraph "a", that was initially
19 established and approved or licensed after December 1, 1998,
20 and that made a written request to the area education agency
21 for educational services at least ninety days prior to the
22 placement of children at the facility, shall be reimbursed by
23 the department of revenue and finance for the facility's costs
24 of providing the appropriate educational services to children
25 placed at the facility for the 1999-2000 school year. The
26 reimbursable costs shall be approved pursuant to section
27 282.31 and applicable administrative rules. Any amount paid
28 by the department of revenue and finance shall be deducted
29 monthly from the state foundation aid paid under section
30 257.16 to all school districts in the state during the
31 subsequent fiscal year.

32 EXPLANATION

33 This bill authorizes an area education agency to provide
34 educational services to a newly established approved or
35 licensed shelter care home or a newly established approved

1 juvenile detention home if the facility makes a request for
2 the services 90 days prior to the beginning of the time for
3 which the services are requested. The provision is applicable
4 to a facility approved or licensed after December 1, 1998.
5 Currently, an area education agency can only provide
6 educational services to an approved or licensed shelter care
7 home or an approved juvenile detention home if the facility
8 makes a request for educational services by December 1 of the
9 school year prior to the beginning of the school year for
10 which the services are being requested.

RELATING TO PAYMENT OF EDUCATION COSTS FOR CERTAIN JUVENILE
FACILITIES AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 282.30, subsection 1, paragraph b,
unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1999, is amended to read as
follows

c. An area education agency shall not provide educational
services to a facility specified in paragraph "a" unless the
facility makes a request for educational services to the area
education agency by either of the following dates:

(1) December 1 of the school year prior to the beginning
of the school year for which the services are being requested.

(2) Ninety days prior to the beginning of the time for
which the services are being requested if the facility is a
newly established facility.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE -- FACILITIES FOR 1999-2000 SCHOOL
YEAR. Section 1 of this Act, amending section 282.30 and
relating to educational services provided to a facility by an
area education agency, being deemed of immediate importance,
takes effect upon enactment. A facility described in section
282.30, subsection 1, paragraph "a", that was initially
established and approved or licensed after December 1, 1998,
and that made a written request to the area education agency
for educational services at least ninety days prior to the
placement of children at the facility, shall be reimbursed by
the department of revenue and finance for the facility's costs
of providing the appropriate educational services to children
placed at the facility for the 1999-2000 school year. The
reimbursable costs shall be approved pursuant to section
282.31 and applicable administrative rules. Any amount paid

by the department of revenue and finance shall be deducted
monthly from the state foundation aid paid under section
257.16 to all school districts in the state during the
subsequent fiscal year.
